There are many Apps that can be adapted for use in genealogy research. My lecture mentions Apps in a variety of categories. ### Note Taking and Keeping Organized:


[Evernote](#) –  Evernote can change the way you organize your genealogy (and other) projects. Take notes, create to-do lists, and save things you find online into Evernote. Everything is synced between your phone/tablet and computer automatically. (Using two platforms is free – for additional syncing there is a cost)


[Microsoft OneNote](#) -  With OneNote you have the flexibility to type, write or draw. You can search and clip from the web. You can invite family, friends and/or coworkers to work together on projects with you. Shared notebooks can contain memories, different projects, photos and more.


[Trello](#) -  Working with a series of reorganizable and customizable Boards, Trello can be a powerful tool to use on your own or collaborating with others. The possibilities are only limited by your imagination.

[Slack](#) -  Slack is team oriented. You can have shared conversations with a variety of groupings – one-on-one to whole, larger groups. It is possible to share documents and work together.

### Your Files on the Go:


[Dropbox](#) -  The files you have uploaded to Dropbox are then available to you as you move around without having to carry your computer everywhere. You can also share files with individuals or groups that you set up.

[Google Drive](#) -  Files saved to Google Drive can be worked on by several individuals at the same time and you can see the changes made in real time. You choose with whom to share each document. The files are available in all formats.

[Microsoft OneDrive](#) -  A cloud oriented service from Microsoft to access your files and photos from anywhere. You can work on documents across platforms.

**Spreadsheets:** Different options exist and may have more limited abilities in tablet format, but your files can be accessed as you travel around.
