


Legacy 9 Unlocked (part 9): Adding an Entry from an Online Database by Geoff Rasmussen

Summary of Steps for an Online Database

1. Create the To Do item and perform the research
2. Set up the source clipboard
3. Analyze and add the new data, and source as you go
4. Close/complete the To Do item
5. Plan for future research
6. File the paper document, if applicable
