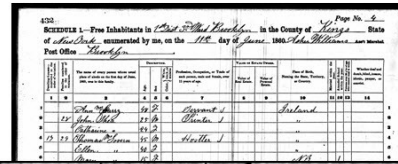

Here's your outline of steps to follow when adding a census record to Legacy Family Tree.

Summary of Steps

1. Create the To Do item and perform the research
2. Set up the source clipboard
3. Analyze and add the new data, including the census event, share the event with the other individuals, and source as you go
4. Close/complete the To Do item
5. Plan for future research
6. File the paper document, if applicable
