A person's life is lived 24 hours a day, and includes much more than birth, marriage and death. A person is involved in all facets of everyday life and we just need to think where to look for the sources that will tell these stories, and in what archive they may be found. The sources can deal with the socio-economic situation, immigration, the community, politics, education, occupation, youth movements and others. The aim of the lecture is to show examples of various sources and in which archives or types of archives they can be found, including the internet and social media. The next step will be for the audience to incorporate the ideas presented into their own family research. The approach used is chronological, following the growth of a person in almost any country in the world. It can also be useful for developing questions to ask.

Most of the examples are from the Israel Genealogy Research Association's [IGRA] All Israel Database (AID) collection. http://genealogy.org.il. The following list is just to give you some ideas. Most of the resources deal with Israel, but some are abroad and deal with activities in other parts of the world.

School/Education

Year Books – this is something not common in Israel, but popular in others countries.

Class Pictures – in Israel various local archives have been collecting them.

Jubilee Books – these are usually for schools that have been around for 50 years or more, and are sometimes found in libraries or today may be part of the website for the school. IGRA has transcribed a few.

Websites – if the school doesn't have archival information on their website, they may know where it is stored.
