


Watch Geoff Live: Adding a Marriage Record using Legacy 10

Refer to the steps below which serve as the outline of what to do in Legacy Family Tree 10 when you find a document online.

Summary of Steps

1. Create the To Do item and perform the research.
2. Set up the source clipboard.
3. Analyze and add the new data, including the marriage event, share the event with the FANs, sourcing as you go.
4. Add the digital image to the event.
5. Close/complete the To Do item.
6. Plan for future research.
7. File the paper document, if applicable.
