Introduction

The Genealogical Society of Utah (GSU) was organized in 1894 in Salt Lake City. The society's mission was to enable members to trace their family history. The primary way to do that at the time was through books and correspondence via letters. Since its inception the society, now known as FamilySearch, has amassed the largest genealogical collections in the world. Today users online can access billions of digital images from many countries around the world. Although many records FamilySearch has acquired are available online, it's world-class physical collection largely remains only accessible in Salt Lake City in the FamilySearch Library (FSL).
