**Audience Question:**

**Q:** Can you switch back and forth between married and maiden names? My tree shows the maiden name with married name in parentheses. I didn't know you could display the names reversed in the FT view. Thanks

**A:** Yes you can.

**Audience Question:**

**Q:** What does the black ribbon in the corner represent?

**A:** The person is deceased.

**Audience Question:**

**Q:** How do you get the black strip for those that are deceased?

**A:** The black strip should appear automatically. If it's off, you can turn it on in the Settings area.

**Audience Question:**

**Q:** I have deceased people in my tree who do not have a black ribbon in the corner.

**A:** Look for the "show black ribbons for deceased people" option in the Settings.

**Audience Question:**

**Q:** How would I upload my tree that I have on Family Tree Maker to MyHeritage?

**A:** First, export a GEDCOM in Family Tree Maker. There's a video in the Webinar Library about GEDCOMs: <https://familytreewebinars.com/webinar/transferring-genealogy-gedcom-files>. Then, import into MyHeritage at <https://www.myheritage.com/import-gedcom>

**Audience Question:**

**Q:** How would I do that (change the married/maiden name display)?

**A:** In the Family View, click the Settings button. Then change the option in the Name Preferences section.

**Audience Question:**

**Q:** Where would I set the colors for the tree. I can't seem to find the 4 color option.

**A:** Look for the color palette button in the lower right of the screen in the Pedigree View, Fan View, or Family View.

**Audience Question:**

**Q:** Please show where to find the option to set the black strip on deceased people. I can't seem to find it.

**A:** First, go to the Family View. Then click the Settings button. The option is in the "Card display options" section.

**Audience Question:**

**Q:** The profile page is so much easier to navigate. Thank you!

**A:** Agree!

**Audience Question:**

Q: Where do I find the source citation for records?

A: The Sources tab is found in the row just below the orange heading.

Audience Question:

Q: how did he get to the map from this screen?

A: On the main Profile page for the person, he was on the Details tab. Scroll down and the map appears towards the bottom.

Q: I will definitely be watching this again with MyHeritage open! :)
