Q: What records are available on MyHeritage that are not on the other ancestry-record sites? A: It's hard to tell. Typically they will announce that in a blog post but not on the website itself. For example here's a blog post announcing an exclusive collection.

Q: Can you import information from another website (Ancestry or 23 and Me) to the My Heritage program?

A: Yes. Export your family tree as a gedcom file and then import that into MyHeritage. All the major sites and software programs let you do that.

A: No, you can keep them private or delete them whenever you want. They don't retain copies.

Q: When you upload pictures you can write who they are, can you download the photo with the info you wrote?

A: I don't think you can do that. You can tag the photos to people in your tree but you would need to use a photo program to write notes on the photos.

Q: I uploaded my brother's DNA from a different place, I think it' MyLife DNA and My Heritage said it didn't accept it yet

A: It has to be DNA from 23andMe, Ancestry or FamilyTreeDNA. I'm not sure of any others.

Audience Question:

Q: How do I get the premium DNA tools for a MyHeritage test kit that was purchased? I thought it was automatically included but it wasn't. Thank you!

A: To access MyHeritage's premium DNA tools (like the Chromosome Browser, Ethnicity Estimate, and Shared Ancestral Places), you'll need to either pay a one-time unlock fee of \$29 or maintain a Premium, Premium Plus, Complete, or Omni subscription.

Q: Does MyHeritage charge any fees later if you are not an active member.? Recently we discovered that Ancestry charges a \$5 dollar monthly fee if you close subscription. It also deletes any docs you pulled from their platform.

A: No, they don't. All of their costs are within existing plans. So you would sign up for a plan when you want pre,iu, features. They don't do "a la carte" they way Ancestry has started doing.

Audience Question:

Q: how smoothly does it import data from legacy into. can it take the legacy data and add on to your free account or do you need to subscribe

A: I think there is a limit to how many people you can have in your tree for free. So if you try to upload a very large existing family file you may hit that max limit quickly.
