To Use This Collection:

- Login to MyHeritage.com
- In the Top Bar on the Home Page, Click on **RESEARCH**
- In the Drop-down Menu, Click on **COLLECTION CATALOG**

Click on **HISTORIES, MEMORIES & BIOGRAPHIES**

To Search the Full Collection – 1. Click on Histories, Memories, & Biographies

To Search – 2. Browse Through the Collection List and Click on a Collection

To Search – 3. Enter the Name in the Search Box and Other Data if it is available

To Search by Category - 1. Click on a Collection Category

To Search – 2. Browse through the Collection List and Click on a Collection

To Search – 3. Enter the Name in the Search Box and Other Data if it is available

Refine By Location-HISTORIES, MEMORIES & BIOGRAPHIES

- Canada – 54 Collections with 42,359 Records
- Europe – 407 Collections with 316,927 Records
- Oceania – 24 Collections with 27,248 Records
- USA – 1633 Collections with 2,251,298 Records

To Refine By Location – Click on the Location of Choice. An “X” will be placed next to that location. The Collection List will show only collections from that location. Use the same Search 1-2-3 steps listed above in the Category Search.

A Few Tips for Using the Collections:

When you are actively searching for someone in the MyHeritage databases, pay close attention to the “We Found More Records” columns on the right-hand side of the screen. Check out the suggested Collections for possible new information on your person of interest.

Use the best genealogy sources, like the **Histories, Memories & Biographies Collection**, to verify the information in your tree.

Verify Names, Dates, Places, and Relatives to make sure the information you are adding to your tree is accurate.
