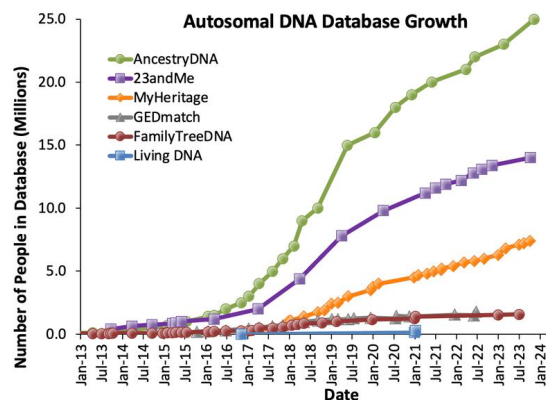

The First Reason to Include MyHeritage DNA: LARGE DATABASE

MyHeritage has the third-largest autosomal DNA database.

The Second Reason to Include MyHeritage DNA: MULTI-PROFILE MANAGEMENT

- Some DNA testing companies require a separate log-in for each tester.
- MyHeritage let you get every kit you manage into this single database and then access them all conveniently. There's no need to log out and log back in for every different person.
- Having more family members in the database can yield more useful information.

The Third Reason to Include MyHeritage DNA: CHEEK SWABS

Since many people cannot spit saliva into a tube, swab kits are more inclusive. This may seem like a small point unless it's you or someone you desperately want to test who can only be tested with a swab kit.

Where Swab Kits Work Better:

- The very young
- The very old
- Anyone with xerostomia (dry mouth)
- The recently deceased*

*Many funeral directors will collect a sample for you if you have a swab test kit.
